



CODE OF CONDUCT

As a member of the LVDL community, we expect you to adhere to the following code of conduct, noting that a breach of the terms of this Code of Conduct may result in disciplinary action in line with our policies and at the discretion of the Executive Committee.

Definition:

The term "member" for the purpose of this Code of Conduct refers to any player, fill-in, organizer, assistant, helper, ball retriever, spectator or participant at any LVDL round, tournament or event. We expect our registered members to do their best to ensure that any person(s) they bring to an LVDL round, tournament or event abide by this Code of Conduct.

Member Conduct:

We expect our members to:

- Promote the sport of Dodgeball in a respectful manner
- Respect the Leadership Team
- Respect the decisions of Match Officials and Committee members
- Respect and be courteous to other community members
- Respect the rights and worth of every person, regardless of their age, race, gender, body, ability, cultural background, sexuality or religion
- Read and understand the rules before playing in any competition level games
- Act within the rules and spirit of the sport
- Promote fair play over winning at any cost
- Be honest with any hits on their own person and team, and be able to call themselves out - irrespective if anyone observed the hit or not
- Display appropriate and responsible behavior in all interactions
- Act with integrity and objectivity, and accept responsibility for your decisions and actions
- Ensure your decisions and actions contribute to a safe environment
- Ensure your decisions and actions contribute to a harassment-free environment
- Not demonstrate or tolerate abusive, bullying or threatening behavior
- Be aware of your own and other people's abilities and experience levels and use common sense in gameplay
- Abide by the laws/rules of the local area in which you are present at all times
